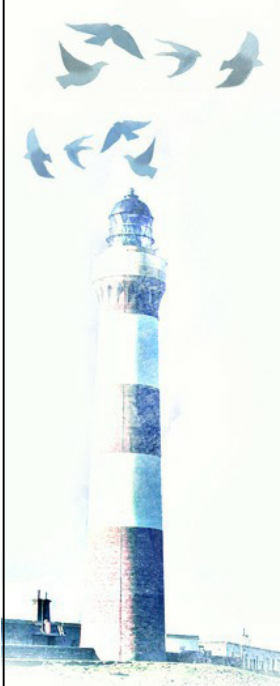

Turbine Track



There have been a number of instances over this summer where car racing and dangerous driving has taken place at the community turbine site. The Board of REWIRED Ltd have had to take measures to protect the site and the substation as it contains high voltage electrical switches, by placing large boulders on the crane pad area in front of the turbine. If the substation is damaged by a vehicle losing control, the driver could be killed or seriously injured, or the site could be rendered non-operational for a considerable period of time whilst repairs are made, resulting in a loss of income to the community projects we support. This is a potentially dangerous operational site and not a play area. The “No Unauthorised Vehicles Beyond This Point” sign is at the bottom of the turbine access track for a reason. Please respect this community owned asset.
