The systems would be tied into Orkney's smart grid allowing your power consumption for the SMILE assets to be occasionally managed at times. Such periods occurring when the grid requires more power demand to allow community-owned wind turbines to keep turning, when these would otherwise be turned off.

Your property needs:

- Plumbed wet heating (radiators/underfloor)
OR a hot water tank we can replace and upgrade

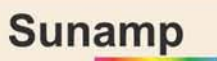
